Onsite Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Checklist



- Signed Registration Statement
- Site Construction General Permit Coverage Letter issued by DEQ
- Virginia 2019 Construction General Permit
- Stormwater calculations provided by the site engineer
- Delegation of Authority to whomever will be responsible for stormwater management on the site
- Identification of qualified stormwater manager for the project, including name, company, and contact information
- Identification of company/person responsible for any activity that may impact stormwater on the site, to include excavation, concrete placement, landscaping activities, paving, painting, and any other work that could impact stormwater management
- Subcontractor agreement that they understand their responsibilities in regards to stormwater management
Grading/stabilization log for any ground disturbing activities and stabilization measures
- Inspection reports performed on the appropriate interval
- Red line plans of site, indicating when land disturbing activities are started/completed, when areas are stabilized, and where pollutant generating activities may be located (to include, but not limited to, temporary toilets, equipment staging/fueling, concrete washout, dumpsters, material storage)
